Notes on Applying For KidSight Certification

Your will need to go the Lions KidSightUSA website, study the content as described below and take the certification exam.

Go to the Lions KidSightUSA website certification page:

Google Lions KidSight USA Select Lions KidSight USA Foundation link Click link near the top of the page labeled **Get Certified.** Or, hold control key and click the link below.

On this Certification web page, there are three links in the center this page:

The first link takes you to a webpage with links to three Lions KidSight USA webinars and other instructional videos. View the first three videos which are numbered Part 1 through Part 3 (12:21, 18:35 and 13:35 minutes respectively) of the Lions KidSight USA Project webinar. They contain information on why we vision screen, the conditions of the eye that vision screening will detect and how to vision screen. For Parts 1, 2 and 3, the links are one this webpage. You only need to view the first 9 minutes of Part 3. You may also want to view the video How to Use the Welch Allyn Spot Vision Screener before you have your training session on using this screener, but that subject matter will not be on the certification exam.

Go back to the Certification web page. The second link is the KidSight Training manual. Click on the training manual icon. You can either view it on-line or download it to your computer. There are 16 pages in this manual. Spend some time reading and digesting this, as this is where most of the questions on the certification exam will come from.

Once you feel comfortable with the manual, PDG Dan Uitti has created a generic LOGIN for the Lions of Arizona to take the exam. **Note: Be sure to know your LCI Membership ID#.** (Note: If you don't have an LCI Membership ID #, use the numeral "0".) They recommend that you use a real computer and not a Tablet (iPad) or SmartPhone. There are approximately 50 multiple choice questions and it should take around 20 minutes. Note: Some of the questions may have more than one right answer, so chose the multiple choice answer that fully answers the question (for example – All of the above.) If you stay in the module too long (ie. searching for answers), it may time out. Read the description below:

This generic login will work for anyone, so you don't need pre-registration to take the test. You only need to know what Study guides to use... It is an OPEN BOOK test.

Click on the third link on the certification webpage that says: <u>Sign In here</u> Or hold control key and click on this link: <u>http://e-district.org/sites/kidsightusa/page-11.php</u> Log into the Members Section at the left: Username: **az** Password: **KidUSA** Then proceed to the Test. The first section asks for your email address, name, District, State and **Membership ID#** The second section of 50 guestions. When you have completed the test, you will get an email from Google Forms with your Answers. But this is not the results. At some time later, Lion Dan will provide you with the "Results - Score" and if you passed, you will be provided with a PDF file of the Certificate showing that you have passed successfully. * **If you don't hear from him in 2 days, e-mail him** and he will look for your 'answers'...

Included at the bottom of the Certificate is an indication where the Certificate can be validated by another agency with your permission.
