



Lions Screen Kids Sight

Memorandum of Understanding for Screening for Vision Problems

This agreement is between Lions, sponsored by Lions Club(s) volunteering for the Lions of Yavapai project "Lions Screen Kids Sight", and this district, school or facility:

It addresses performance of eye sight screening for students in pre-K through second grades and fourth grade or these grade levels _____ selected at this school's discretion and/or prescribed by ADHS rule, who are registered at this school on the date(s) of the screening. **Initials of the district, school or facility:** _____

The Lions will use Welch Allyn Spot Vision Screener(s). This is a sophisticated instrument- based vision screening, but it is not a diagnosis nor is it performed by certified health personnel. It is not equivalent to a comprehensive eye and vision examination. Lions will provide each student's screening result to the school, including recommended referrals for professional eye examination.

For District or Charter Schools

Prior to the screening, the school or district will ensure it has identified each student for whom a parent or guardian has submitted to the school a statement of objection for any reason to screening their student. The school will ensure no student is presented to the Lions for screening for whom such objection was submitted. The school will provide a staff member present in their facility- provided screening area whenever students are present.

For Pre-School and Private Schools

Prior to the screening, the school or facility will ensure a currently effective completed consent form is on file with the student identified by name and signed by the student's parent or guardian for every student to be screened. The facility will ensure no student is presented to the Lions for screening for whom such consent is not on file. The facility will provide a staff member present in their facility-provided screening area whenever students are present.

The Arizona Lions members conducting the vision screening will not be held accountable for any errors of commission, omission or misdiagnosis.

The responsible district, school or facility will communicate to parent or guardian in every case that the screening indicates their student's need for a comprehensive eye and vision examination. The staff will follow up on such referrals for professional diagnosis of potential vision problems.

This MOU is in effect for two school years, unless superseded.
