

Tips For Color Testing

1. Hold the book approximately arms-length away.
2. Tilt book up to make sure that the test plates are at a 90° angle. Do not lie the book flat on the table.
3. The first plate is a demonstration plate and the student should see a star, circle and square.
4. Confirm that students know their shapes by pointing to them and asking them.
5. Have students use a Q-Tip to outline each shape if they have trouble saying the shapes.
6. Tell the student that on each test plate there may be no symbol, one, two or all three of the above symbols.
7. If the student doesn't see anything, have the student answer by saying, "Nothing."
8. You have 30 seconds on each test plate.
9. Mark each response on the scoresheet, correct or incorrect.
10. Use a new line on the scoresheet for each new student.
11. A student must correctly identify 8 of the 9 plates to pass.
12. For students that do not know their shapes, use the four plates with the car, dog, boat & house. The car is a demonstration page.
13. If a student passes, mark a 'P' on the **Right** side of the 3 x 5 card.
14. If a student doesn't pass, mark an 'N' for Nonconforming on the **Right** side of the 3 x 5 card.
